Stewart Towe CBE is the Group Chairman and Managing Director of Hadley Industries Holdings Limited. Trained as an Accountant with the Birmingham firm of Farmiloe & Co, Stewart moved into Industry in 1976 on completion of his final exams as Group Accountant and was appointed to the Main Board in 1978, taking responsibility for the commercial and financial development of the Group. Stewart completed the buy-out of the business from the Hadley family in April 2006.

Hadley has grown from £1 million annual turnover in the mid 1970's to over £100 million annual turnover in 2010. Growth has been primarily by product development, and not acquisition. Hadley now have manufacturing plants in the Middle East, Far East and Europe and licensees throughout the world.
